Coach Jennings Brain Bowl!!

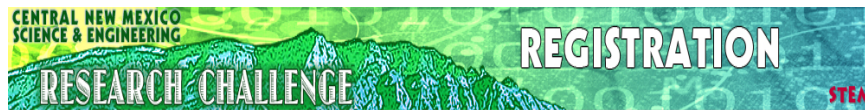
I had the opportunity to stop by the gym and play a game of bowling! How lucky our students are to have so many wonderful experiences! Thanks Coach!
